## *‘Little and Often’*

At St Barnabas Church, we are working to meet the needs of our community, both for Christian worship on a Sunday and by providing a venue where community groups can meet. However, this doesn't come cheap!

It costs around £15,000 per annum to keep St Barnabas Church & Halls open (in terms of maintenance, utilities etc.), however, if we were to have a full-time priest this would cost an additional £50,000.

Additionally, the PCC of St Barnabas are working to make the best use of the facilities we can so as to allow more community groups to use the church & halls and to further this, we are raising money to have a small kitchen & toilet facilities put into the church. This will cost around £25,000 but will be an investment for the future.

We would ask that if you would like to see St Barnabas remain open for community use and worship, please make a donation or set up a standing order to donate regularly, no matter how small your donation – a *little and often* will make a difference. After all, while £2 a month may not seem like a lot, if 50 people donate then that's £100 a month or £1,200 a year.

All money received from this campaign will be designated for use for one of the following:

- Internal Reordering of St Barnabas Church for community use
- Maintenance & Development of grounds & building at St Barnabas
- Mission & Ministry at St Barnabas Church
